Napoleon coin found by Ivan Santos in La Réunion area

"La Réunion was a socialist utopian community formed in 1855 by French, Belgian, and Swiss colonists approximately three miles west of the now defunct Reunion Arena and nearby Reunion Tower in downtown Dallas and near the forks of the Trinity River in Texas. The founders of the community were inspired by the utopian thought of the French philosopher François Marie Charles Fourier. Followers of Fourier established 29 similar colonies in various parts of the United States during the 1800s. The colony near present-day Dallas was incorporated into the emerging city of Dallas around 1860."
